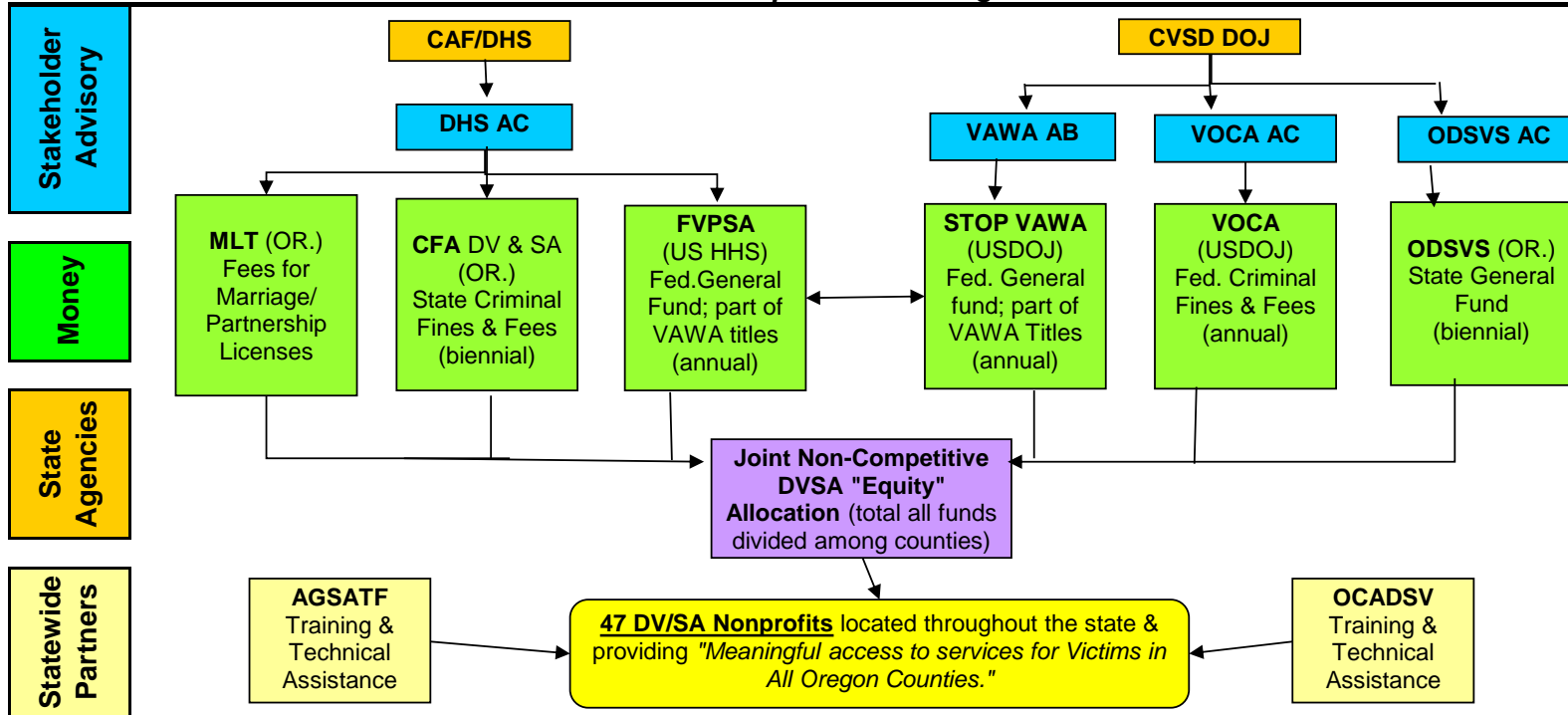


DV/SA NonCompetitive Funding Flow Chart

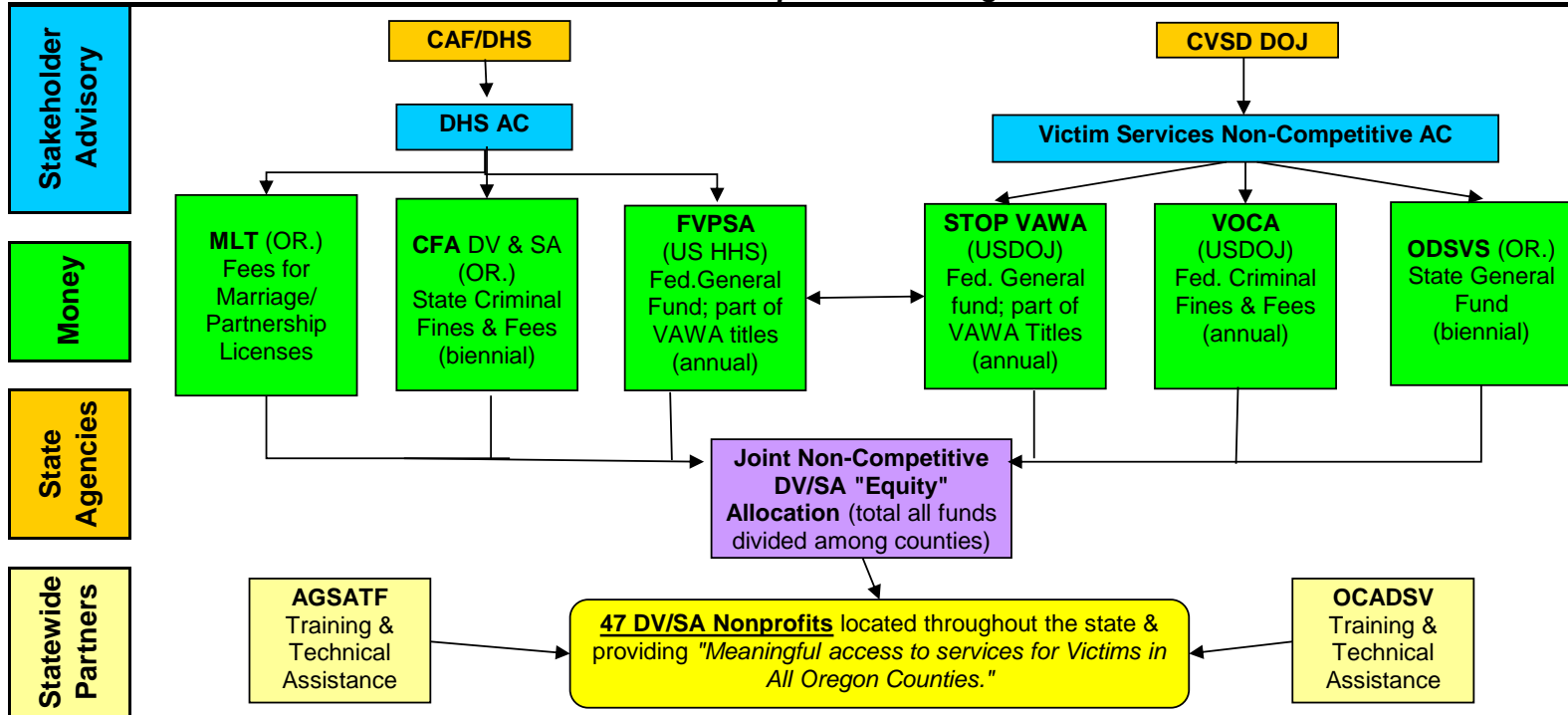
