23 that no provision of this AVC operates as a penalty, forfeiture, or punishment under the

24 Constitution of the United States, under the Constitution of the State of Oregon, or under any

25 other provision of law.

12	submitted to the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Marion County for approval, and, i
13	approved, will be filed with the court pursuant to ORS 646.632(2).

15	Respondent waives any further notice of submission to and filing with the court of this
16	AVC. Respondent agrees to accept service of a court certified copy by email.

18	If monies which are ordered to be paid in this AVC are not paid timely, DOJ may convert
19	the AVC to a money judgment under ORS 646.632(2) without notice to respondent. Respondent
20	agrees that a copy of the money judgment may be sent to Respondent via first class mail to the
21	addresses following its signature or to that of its attorney.

23	Respondent shall not represent or imply that DOJ acquiesces or approves of respondent's
24	past business practices, current efforts to reform their practices, or any future practices which
25	respondent may adopt or consider adopting. DOJ's decision to settle this matter or to otherwise

14	Within 15 days of the execution of this AVC, Respondent shall refund the consumers
15	listed below, in the amounts indicated. Refunds shall be paid by check, made out to the
16	consumer for the amount indicated and sent to DOJ to be forwarded to these consumers.

21	Effective immediately, Respondent shall issue a full refund to any Oregon consumer who
22	files a valid, unsolicited complaint with DOJ.

24	Within 30 days of execution of this AVC, Respondent shall pay the sum of \$13,500 to
25	DOJ for deposit to the Oregon Department of Justice Protection and Education Account
26	established pursuant to ORS 180.095.

2	Within 15 days of execution of this AVC, Respondent shall re-write all of its Oregon call
3	scripts to:
4	(a) comply with the 30-second rule of ORS 646.611, including immediately
5	discontinuing the call if the consumer indicates that they do not wish to listen to a
6	solicitation;
7	(b) clearly state the total cost of the goods or services being sold, at the time those goods
8	or services are described.
9	(c) no longer offer "free" airline tickets or any other "free" prize or gift to Oregon
10	consumers;
11	(d) reiterate that free membership is available before explaining the different types of
12	membership that are for sale.

14	Respondent agrees that, in addition to any other sanctions which may be imposed under
15	this AVC or under the law, any future violation of the terms of this AVC may result in civil
16	penalties of \$25,000 for each violation, and Respondent will be subject to such further relief as
17	the court may deem appropriate.
