24	1. Respondent is registered with the Or	regon Attorney General as a charitable			
25	organization engaged in solicitations or otherwise doing business in Oregon and has the

- 2 the Attorney General was for the 2013 fiscal year. Respondent's total functional expenses and

- 4 are set forth below.

- 3. Respondent filed its 2014 IRS Form 990 and financial report with the Attorney
- General on October 13, 2015. The 2014 financial report reflected total expenses of \$706,335 and
- program expenses of \$166,346 for a ratio of 23.6%. If the 2014 report was considered and the
- period used to calculate the three-year average was 2012-2014, Respondent's program service
- 15 expenditure ratio would be 22.7%. Respondent would still be subject to disqualification.
- 4. Respondent is not exempt from disqualification under ORS 128.760(4) and does not
- 17 warrant exemption under ORS 128.760(2) and OAR 137-010-0032.

## **Ultimate Findings of Fact**

- 20 Respondent's program service expenditures averaged over the applicable years is less
- 21 than 30 percent of its total expenditures and Respondent is not otherwise exempt from
- 22 disqualification.

## **Conclusions of Law**

- Because Respondent has failed to expend at least 30 percent of its total annual functional
- 26 expenses on program services, as reflected in its IRS Form 990, Part IX Statement of Functional

10	Order remains in effect for a minimum of one year and will continue until such time as		
11	Respondent submits information to demonstrate that its program services expenses meet the		
12	minimum percentage specified in ORS 128.760(1).
