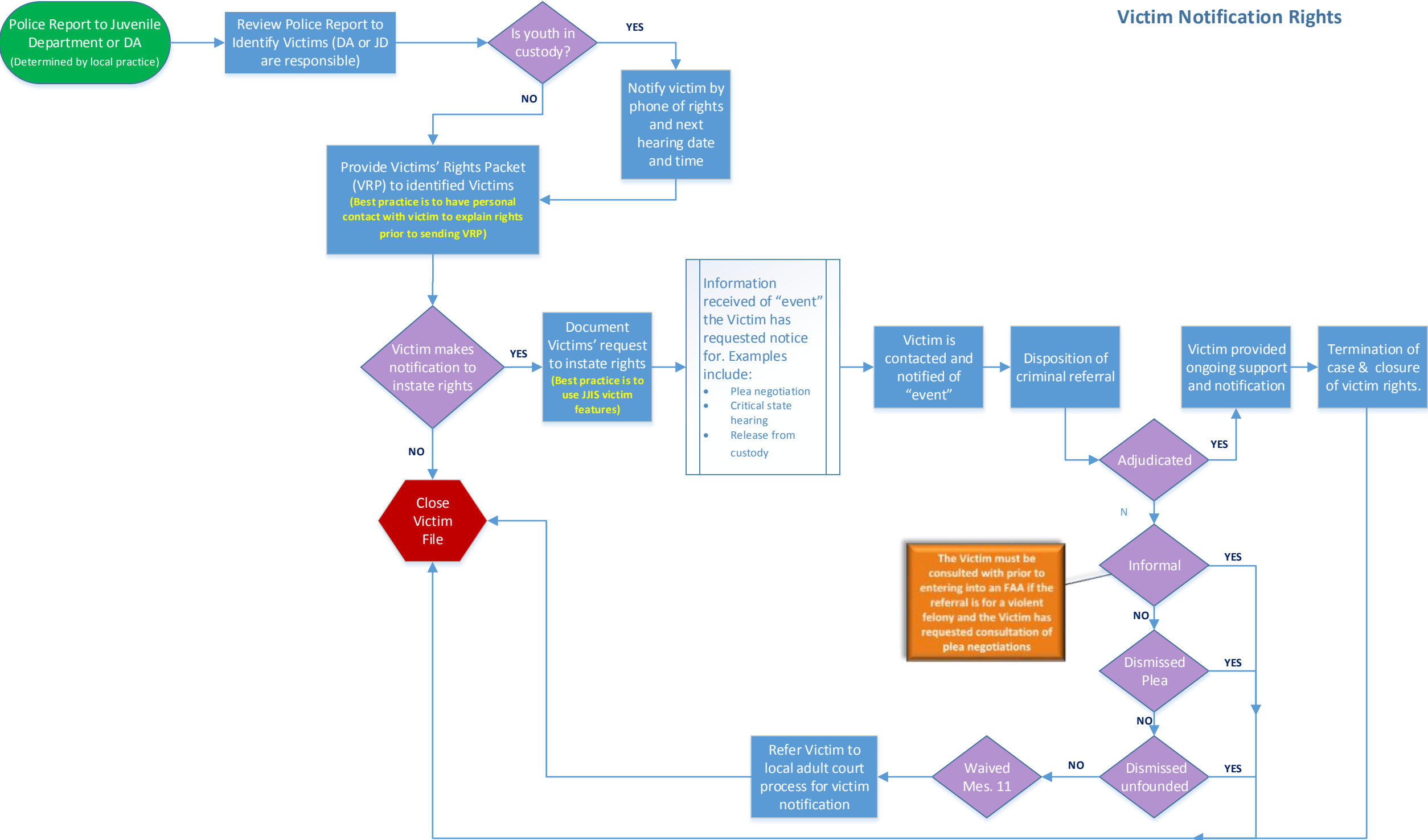


Victim Notification Rights



Police Report to Juvenile Department or DA (Determined by local practice)

Review Police Report to Identify Victims (DA or JD are responsible)

Is youth in custody?

YES

Notify victim by phone of rights and next hearing date and time

NO

Provide Victims' Rights Packet (VRP) to identified Victims (Best practice is to have personal contact with victim to explain rights prior to sending VRP)

Victim makes notification to instate rights

YES

Document Victims' request to instate rights (Best practice is to use JJIS victim features)

NO

Close Victim File

Information received of "event" the Victim has requested notice for. Examples include:
• Plea negotiation
• Critical state hearing
• Release from custody

Victim is contacted and notified of "event"

Disposition of criminal referral

Victim provided ongoing support and notification

Termination of case & closure of victim rights.

The Victim must be consulted with prior to entering into an FAA if the referral is for a violent felony and the Victim has requested consultation of plea negotiations
