A concern was raised by some stakeholders regarding the lack of confidentiality of communications that are shared with/among parties during the assessment phase of mediation before the point at which an agreement to mediate is executed (Current rules allow the mediator to keep these communications confidential, but not the parties, unless an agreement to mediate is subsequently executed.) Part of the discussion at the last meeting focused on whether additional confidentiality was needed, how confidentiality could be achieved if it is desirable, and ways to distinguish this stage in the process/event from other routine governmental activities where confidentiality is not desirable.
