We filed a notice of temporary rulemaking that is effective February 27, 2018. A summary of the rule change is listed below. This summary is provided as a courtesy only and may not be a complete statement of the rule changes. Summary of rule change:

OAR 137-055-1140 Confidentiality of Records in the Child Support Program, is amended to clarify that certain personal information about the parties may be disclosed when it is for purposes directly connected to the administration of the Child Support Program, but otherwise should be redacted. It further clarifies that unless the full number is specifically required, all but the last four digits of a party's social security number, financial institution account information, or driver's license number must be redacted.
