Summary of rule change:

Distribution and Disbursement

OAR 137-055-6022 is amended to specify that current rule provisions only apply to cases managed in the Child Support Enforcement Automated System (CSEAS). Adds a new section specifying distribution and disbursement provisions for cases managed in the Origin child support automated system, which includes the distribution hierarchy for all case types; Removes provisions regarding parentage testing fees as these are no longer collected or charged by the Program.
