

SAMPLE PUBLIC RECORDS REQUEST FOR CHILD SUPPORT DATA

Relevant to ORS 25.260 - Child support records, including data contained in the Child Support Program's automated system are confidential and may be disclosed or used only as necessary for the administration of the program.

- Number of child support payers currently in the Child Support Program, ideally split by geography (zip code, county, etc)
 - total
 - number of people
 - amount of money owed/to be paid
 - delinquent
 - number of people
 - amount of money owed/to be paid
- Conduct and performance audits done by the DOJ under ORS 180.345 (2)

Relevant to ORS 25.792 - ORS 25.790 requires employers to report hiring and rehiring information to DOJ's Division of Child Support. ORS 25.792 makes the information submitted by employers confidential and exempt from public disclosure.

- Names of employers who have reported hiring/rehiring employees to the DOJ Division of Child Support within the last 12 months
 - Number of employees at each employer
 - dates of hire/rehire
 - ideally split up by number of hires/employer/month
- If can't give names all names, just provide names of government employers and how many hires/rehires in last 12 months
- If can't give any names of employers at all, split up number of employers and employees by zip code or other kind of geography
