Bias Response Hotline Data 2022

Total Hotline reports so far in 2022: 2,384

Of those, 119 reports have been anti-Jewish bias, accounting for 5% of all reports to the Hotline.

Breakdown of anti-Jewish reports:

- 28 Felony Hate crimes
- 31 Misdemeanor Hate crimes
- 60 Bias incidents


This is 50% criminal and 50% bias incidents. As a reference point, for targeting all other protected classes, crimes are about 30% of reports to the Hotline, while incidents are about 60% of reports (with bias against non-protected classes, unable to determine, and bias criteria not met making up the remaining percentage points).

This year, anti-Jewish bias is more criminal than targeting of any other protected class by far (including anti-Black bias, which usually is comparable percentage-wise to anti-Semitic criminal targeting, but this year it is not—31% of anti-Black reports are criminal).

Within religion (183 reports this year), anti-Jewish bias makes up 65% of the reporting we have received.

In 2020 and 2021, we received a total of 131 anti-Jewish reports:

- 34 anti-Jewish reports in 2020
- 97 anti-Jewish reports in 2021
