Minutes Approval – The Batterer Intervention Program (BIP) Advisory Committee (AC) approved the minutes of the July 22, 2022 meeting, which will be posted to the Department of Justice website.

Strength at Home Update

Aaron Hartman reported that the Lane County Community Corrections Director has had experience with the Strength at Home program for justice-involved participants. They are using a Supervisory Authority Team-approved pilot project for veterans in their county system. The report reflected a positive experience and supportive tone; noting a dosage of 100 to 150 hours. The AC will continue to look into the process to learn more about it as there is some indication of significant departure from BIP standards. No one else in the group has been able to gather more information to date.

Women Who Use Force Subcommittee Update

The group approved the work the subcommittee has done on the standards for women who use force. The subcommittee will move forward to finalize the work and forward it to Shannon for submission to the Oregon Administrative Rule process.

The <u>Batterer Intervention Services Coalition of Michigan conference</u> is scheduled for October 25-27. Eric Mankowski and Chris Huffine will both present there. The theme is innovative concepts.
