- Climate-driven disasters and the years-long investment in recovery



Current State of Nonprofits in Oregon

- Over 23,500 nonprofits in Oregon working to lead change
- Huge number of staff and volunteers dedicated to communities
- Total private \$\$ raised and private donor retention went down in 2022
- Huge tranches of \$\$ from government (Cares Act, ARPA, Infrastructure Act and Inflation Reduction Act)




